For example, if any federal funds are included in funding the grant award(s), agencies must include, in the terms and conditions of the grant, the following: Recipients of Federal Funds shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits recipients of federal financial assistance from excluding from a program or activity, denying benefits of, or otherwise discriminating against a person based on race, color, or national origin (42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq.). Additional Nondiscrimination prohibitions in federal statutes, regulations, and executive orders include sex, age, disability, or limited-English proficiency.
